6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Evidence Code;
8 authorizing motion for post adjudication evidentiary
9 hearing to present certain evidence; authorizing
10 court to take certain actions; providing for
11 codification; and providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2706 of Title 12, unless there
15 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 A party may petition or file a motion with a court of competent
17 jurisdiction to request a post adjudication evidentiary hearing to
18 present evidence of material facts not previously presented and
19 heard by the court. Such evidence may include forensic scientific
20 evidence that was not available to be offered by the party at trial
21 or that disputes forensic scientific evidence relied on by the state
22 at trial. At the conclusion of the hearing, the court may alter,
23 modify or vacate a previous judgment.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective in accordance with
2 the provisions of Section 58 of Article V of the Oklahoma
3 Constitution.
