- 3 The ABLE Commission is hereby authorized to promulgate rules В. which are necessary to carry out the purpose of this section and to 4 5 prevent its circumvention by offering or giving of any rebate, allowance, free goods, discount or any other thing or service of 6 7 value; provided, the posting or invoicing of charges per order for processing minimum orders or per case for the handling or repacking 9 of goods by wine and spirits wholesalers and beer distributors for sales in less than full case lots shall not constitute a violation 10 of this section. 11
- C. For the violation of any provision of this section or of any rule duly promulgated under this section, the ABLE Commission may suspend or revoke a license as follows:
- 1. For a first offense, not exceeding ten (10) days' suspension of license;
- 2. For a second offense, not exceeding thirty (30) days' suspension of license; and
  - 3. For a third offense, the ABLE Commission shall revoke the license.
