16	A. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority (OHCA) shall seek
17	Medicaid waiver authority to pursue modifications to Medicaid
18	eligibility criteria so that receipt of SoonerCare coverage is
19	conditional upon documentation of certain education, skills,
20	training, work or job activities. Insure Oklahoma eligibility
21	criteria is excluded from this requirement. This requirement is
22	contingent upon approval from the federal Centers for Medicare and
23	Medicaid Services and available state funding.

B. The SoonerCare eligibility criteria shall be the same as that which exists for the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) or Temporary Assistance for Needy Families Program (TANF), which must meet a certain threshold of hours and type of activity. Such eligibility modifications pursued by the OHCA shall align SoonerCare eligibility to contain criteria for work or job activities in the same manner as SNAP or TANF. In order for an enrollee to remain eligible for SoonerCare, they must also comply with the work and job activity requirements for SNAP or TANF.

C. Exemptions to the eligibility criteria shall be the same as that which exists for SNAP or TANF. Populations excluded from the requirements shall include those specified by SNAP or TANF. The state may adopt additional exemptions subject to legislative action, agency rule-making and federal approval.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
