SENATE BILL 199

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to seed dealers and processors;
directing any seed dealer or processor purchasing
mung beans from a producer to report certain
information to the producer; requiring certain
identifiers; requiring certain records be maintained;
providing for inspection; providing for codification;
and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 8-40 of Title 2, unless there is
created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. Any seed dealer or processor purchasing mung beans (*Vigna
radiata*) from a producer shall provide the following to the
producer:

1. A valid weight receipt identifying the entry and exit weight
of the transporting vehicle; and

2. A weight receipt identifying the weight of the mung beans
after cleaning.

1 B. The seed dealer or processor purchasing the mung beans shall
2 individually identify the storage containers to allow traceability
3 to the particular producer.

4 C. The seed dealer or processor shall maintain records of the
5 above for all mung bean transactions for a period of three (3)
6 years.

7 D. The Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry
8 may inspect any seed dealer or processor facility to determine
9 compliance with this law. Any costs of inspection, including
10 mileage and inspector's hourly rate, shall be billed to the
11 facility.

12 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
