- 1 3. Has been released from the custody of the State Department of Corrections; or
  - 4. Has complied with all probation or supervision requirements since being released from the custody of the State Department of Corrections.
  - B. The provisions of this section shall not apply to amounts owed by the person for restitution to a victim pursuant to a court order or child support obligations pursuant to a court order.
  - C. At the conclusion of the automatic deferral time period, the court shall have the authority to:
- 1. Extend the time period for outstanding fines, court costs or 12 fees;
  - 2. Enter into an installment payment plan for the remaining balance of outstanding fines, court costs or fees; or
  - 3. Waive all outstanding fines, court costs or fees.
- SECTION 2. REPEALER Section 1, Chapter 392, O.S.L. 2016
- 17 (22 O.S. Supp. 2016, Section 983a) is hereby repealed.
- SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
