16	Section 2-125), is amended to read as follows:
17	Section 2-125. The Commissioner of Public Safety shall deposit
18	assess and collect costs and fees from subscribers to the Oklahoma
19	Law Enforcement Telecommunications System, to be deposited in the
20	State Treasury to the credit of the Department of Public Safety
21	Restricted Revolving Fund any monies that are derived from user fees
22	and. Such costs and fees expended from the Fund shall be for
23	personnel, recurring user fees, necessary hardware and accessories,
24	installation costs paid by subscribers for terminals that are a part

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of the Oklahoma Law Enforcement Telecommunication Systems. In
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    addition to other purposes authorized by law, expenditures from the
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    Fund shall be used for purchases of terminal equipment, installation
    costs, personnel, and other operating expenses of the Oklahoma Law

    Enforcement Telecommunication Systems of equipment, maintenance and
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    operational expenses for the Oklahoma Law Enforcement
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    Telecommunications System.
