6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to tax administration; authorizing  
8 Oklahoma Tax Commission to require certain employees  
9 to undergo specified criminal history and records  
10 searches; providing for codification; and providing  
11 an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 205.7 of Title 68, unless there  
15 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 The Oklahoma Tax Commission shall be authorized to require  
17 employees of the Commission in positions that have access to Federal  
18 Tax Information and data to supply all information and documentation  
19 required in order to be subjected to a criminal history search by  
20 the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation, as well as be  
21 fingerprinted for submission of the fingerprints through the  
22 Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation to the Federal Bureau of  
23 Investigation for a national criminal history check. The Commission  
24 shall be the recipient of the results of the record check. In

1 accordance with Section 150.9 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes,  
2 this includes a national criminal record with a fingerprint  
3 analysis.

4 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
