SENATE BILL 400

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to resident tuition in higher education; directing the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education to adopt a policy providing for resident tuition for students who meet certain qualifications; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3226.1 of Title 70, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education shall adopt a policy which allows a student to enroll in an institution within The Oklahoma State System of Higher Education and be eligible for resident tuition if the student:

1. Satisfies admission standards as determined by the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education for the appropriate type of institution and has secured admission to, and enrolled in, an institution within The Oklahoma State System of Higher Education;

1 2. Has a grandparent that is a United States citizen, a
2 resident of this state, and has filed a tax return with the Oklahoma
3 Tax Commission for the ten (10) years prior to the student's
4 application; and

5 3. Is a United States citizen.

6 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective January 1, 2018.
