5 AS INTRODUCED

6 An Act relating to counties and county officers;
7 establishing method of property transfer relating to
8 common areas and greenbelts; stating
9 nonapplicability; providing for codification; and
10 providing an effective date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 339.9 of Title 19, unless there
14 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 The board of county commissioners of a county that receives real
16 property, which otherwise was designated as a common area or
17 greenbelt for a neighborhood development, shall have the authority
18 to transfer ownership of such real property to the municipality that
19 created such common area or greenbelt. County governments shall not
20 be responsible for the maintenance of such properties. Transfers
21 authorized by this section shall not apply to those properties not
22 created by municipalities.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
