7 An Act relating to consumer protection; prohibiting
8 automatic renewal provision in rental contracts;
9 providing exception; construing provision; providing
10 for codification; and providing an effective date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 222 of Title 15, unless there is
14 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 No contract for the rental of goods or rental-related services
16 where all or substantially all of the contract terms are drafted by
17 the provider of such goods or services shall contain any automatic
18 renewal provision that extends the initial term of the contract for
19 any period longer than six (6) months, unless the contract provides
20 the nondrafting party with the ability to terminate at any time
21 during the renewal period without penalty by providing notice of not
22 more than sixty (60) days. Nothing in this section shall be
23 construed to prohibit the parties to the contract from entering into
24 a new contract at the end of the initial term of the contract or at

1 any time after an extension of the contract as provided by this
2 section.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.

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
