AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to driver licenses; amending 47 O.S. 2011, Section 6-112, which relates to licenses to be carried and exhibited on demand; modifying certain action; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 6-112, is amended to read as follows:

Section 6-112. A. Every licensee shall have his or her driver license in his or her immediate possession at all times when operating a motor vehicle ~~and shall display the same upon~~. Upon demand of a peace officer, the licensee shall produce and provide physical possession of the driver license to the peace officer. Any person violating this subsection shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished as provided for in Section 17-101 of this title.

B. Any person charged with violating this section who produces in court, on or before the court date, a driver license issued to him or her and valid at the time of his or her arrest shall be

1 entitled to dismissal of such charge without payment of court costs
2 and fine.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
