15	A. As used in this section, "drone" means a powered, aerial
16	vehicle that carries or is equipped with a recording device that
17	does not carry a human operator, uses aerodynamic forces to provide
18	vehicle lift and can fly autonomously or be piloted remotely. A
19	drone may be expendable or recoverable.
20	B. Any person owning or controlling real estate or other
21	premises who voluntarily damages or destroys a drone located on the
22	real estate or premises or within the airspace of the real estate or
23	premises not otherwise regulated by the Federal Aviation
24	Administration, shall, together with any successors in interest, if
