16	VII of the Oklahoma Constitution, all appellate Justices and Judges
17	in Oklahoma shall be automatically retired when the sum of their
18	years of judicial service and age equals eighty (80), if not having
19	previously chosen to retire. Such retirement shall occur upon
20	reaching the sum of eighty (80) regardless of any time remaining in
21	an existing term.
22	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
