SENATE BILL 70

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to common education; directing the State Auditor and Inspector to perform a performance audit on the State Department of Education; requiring the audit to be performed during certain fiscal year; authorizing the State Auditor and Inspector to take custody of certain records; directing the State Auditor and Inspector to meet with the State Superintendent of Public Instruction and the State Board of Education to review certain report; requiring the report to include certain responses; directing filing of report; providing for posting of report on certain website; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-124 of Title 70, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. The State Auditor and Inspector shall perform an independent, comprehensive performance audit on the State Department of Education during the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2017.

B. The State Auditor and Inspector shall have the power to take custody of any records necessary to the performance of the audit but

1 shall minimize actual physical removal of or denial of access to
2 such records.

3 C. At the conclusion of the audit, the State Auditor and
4 Inspector shall meet with the State Superintendent of Public
5 Instruction and the State Board of Education to review the audit
6 report to be issued. The report, when issued, shall include any
7 responses to the audit which the State Superintendent of Public
8 Instruction or the State Board of Education wishes to have included.

9 D. The State Auditor and Inspector shall file the report with
10 the Governor, the President Pro Tempore of the Senate and the
11 Speaker of the House of Representatives. The State Board of
12 Education shall post the completed report to its website.

13 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2017.

14 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
15 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
16 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
17 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
