19	B. Pursuant to the authority provided by Section 8 of Article							
20	VII of the Oklahoma Constitution, a district judge shall have, in							
21	addition to the qualifications required by such section and as part							
22	of his or her experience as a licensed practicing attorney,							
23	experience as lead counsel in a minimum of three (3) jury trials							
24	brought to verdict prior to filing for such office or appointment.
