16	2016, Section 405.3), is amended to read as follows:
17	Section 405.3. A. On or before July 1, 2010, the Department of
18	Human Services shall promulgate rules to establish and maintain the
19	Child Care Restricted Registry, accessible to the public through an
20	online database, to address:
21	1. A procedure for recording individuals on the restricted
22	registry resulting from:
23	a. a substantiated finding of abuse or neglect, as
24	defined in Section 1-1-105 of Title 10A of the

Oklahoma Statutes, by an individual when the abuse or neglect occurred to children while in the care of a child care facility licensed by the Department or by an adult in a family child care home when the adult's presence is incidental to the operation of the family child care home,

- a revocation or denial of a child care facility
 license, and
- c. a specified criminal history of an individual, as defined by rules promulgated by the Department,
- a substantiated finding of abuse or neglect by an individual included in the nontechnical services
 workers abuse registry as provided by Section 1-1950.7
 of Title 63 of the Oklahoma Statutes, and
- e. a revocation of an Oklahoma teaching certificate

 issued pursuant to Section 6-190 of Title 70 of the

 Oklahoma Statutes;
- 2. A procedure to provide notice and an opportunity for review prior to recording an individual on the restricted registry;
- 3. Disclosure requirements for information on the restricted registry; and
- 4. A procedure to prohibit licensure, ownership, employment, unsupervised access to children or residence in a child care facility licensed by the Department of individuals recorded on the

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        C. Nothing in this section shall be construed as to permit the
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    placement of an operator of a child care facility on the Child Care
    Restricted Registry unless the operator:
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        1. Is the subject of a substantiated finding of child abuse or
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    neglect;
        2. Has been subject to a revocation or denial of a child care
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    facility license; or
        3. Has a specified criminal history, as defined by rules
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    promulgated by the Department.
