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13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
14	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2011, Section 166.7, as
15	amended by Section 839, Chapter 304, O.S.L. 2012 (74 O.S. Supp.
16	2016, Section 166.7), is amended to read as follows:
17	Section 166.7. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a
18	revolving fund for the Commission on Rehabilitation Services, to be
19	designated the "Rehabilitation Services Disbursing Fund" provided
20	that the fund may be designated by fiscal year designations as the
21	Commission may determine. The fund shall be a continuing fund, not
22	subject to fiscal year limitations. The fund shall consist of
23	receipts from the federal government, monies appropriated to the
24	Department of Rehabilitation Services by the State Legislature,

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taxpayer donations made pursuant to Section 166.9 of this title and other receipts of the Department of Rehabilitation Services as shall be directed by the Commission for Rehabilitation Services. All monies accruing to the credit of said the fund are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the Commission for Rehabilitation Services as may be necessary in order to carry out the duties imposed upon the said Commission by law. Expenditures from the Rehabilitation Services Disbursing Fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services for approval and payment.
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SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2017.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
