SENATE BILL 759

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to soldiers and sailors; establishing a pilot program for certain therapy for veterans; directing promulgation of rules and development of policies; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 366 of Title 72, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The Department of Veterans Affairs shall hereby be required to establish an online pilot program to identify, develop and provide cost effective access to magnetic EEG/EKG-guided resonance therapy technology to veterans who suffer from post-traumatic stress disorder, traumatic brain injury or chronic pain.

The Oklahoma Veterans Commission shall promulgate rules and the Department shall develop policies to carry out the provisions of this section.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
