SENATE BILL 773

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the Oklahoma Medicaid Program; directing Oklahoma Health Care Authority to initiate certain procedures; providing assistance from other agencies; specifying certain consideration; directing promulgation of rules; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5028.1 of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority, with assistance from the Department of Human Services and the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services, shall initiate a request for proposal for care coordination models for children birth to eighteen (18) years of age in the custody of the Department of Human Services.

B. Any request for proposal shall require consideration of and incorporate efforts to continue the implementation of relevant initiatives as provided by the Master Settlement Agreement

3 C. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority Board shall promulgate
4 rules to implement the provisions of this act.

5 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.

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
