5 AS INTRODUCED

6 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Health Care  
7 Authority; requiring examination of certain  
8 information; directing submission of report;  
9 specifying contents; providing for codification; and  
10 providing an effective date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 230.79 of Title 56, unless there  
14 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 The Oklahoma Health Care Authority shall conduct a study to  
16 examine the feasibility of using telemedicine to provide health  
17 education and treatment services. On or before December 31, 2017,  
18 the Authority shall submit a report to the President Pro Tempore of  
19 the Senate, the Speaker of the House of Representatives and the  
20 Governor estimating the potential costs or savings to the state,  
21 reviews of pilot projects and research from other states.

22 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective September 1, 2017.
