- B. The task force shall be comprised of nine (9) members to be appointed as follows:
 - 1. Two members appointed by the Governor;

- 6 2. Two members appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the 7 Senate;
- 8 3. Two members appointed by the Speaker of the House of 9 Representatives;
 - 4. A member representing the Department of Corrections;
- 5. A member representing the faith based community of this state; and
- 6. A member representing the Oklahoma Department of Career and Technology Education.
- 15 The chair of the task force shall be selected by the Governor.
- C. A quorum of the task force shall be required to approve any final action of the task force. For purposes of this section, five (5) members shall constitute a quorum.
- D. The task force may meet as often as may be required in order to perform the duties imposed upon it. The chair shall call the first meeting and all subsequent meetings shall be made at the call of the chair.
- E. The meetings of the task force shall be subject to the Oklahoma Open Meeting Act.
