14	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 43A O.S. 2011, Section 1-110, as
15	last amended by Section 1, Chapter 374, O.S.L. 2016 (43A O.S. Supp.
16	2017, Section 1-110), is amended to read as follows:
17	Section 1-110. A. Sheriffs and peace officers shall be
18	responsible for transporting individuals to and from designated
19	sites or facilities for the purpose of examination, emergency
20	detention, protective custody and inpatient services.
21	B. A municipal law enforcement agency shall be responsible for
22	any individual found within such municipality's jurisdiction. The
23	county sheriff shall be responsible for any individual found outside
24	of a municipality's jurisdiction, but within the county.

C. The law enforcement agency transporting an individual to and from designated sites or facilities pursuant to the provisions of this section shall maintain responsibility for the transportation of such individual pending completion of the examination, emergency detention, protective custody and inpatient services.

- D. Sheriffs and peace officers shall be entitled to reimbursement from the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services for transportation services associated with minors or adults requiring examination, emergency detention, protective custody and inpatient services.
- E. Any transportation provided by a sheriff or deputy sheriff or a peace officer on behalf of any county, city, town or municipality of this state, to or from any facility for the purpose of examination, admission, interfacility transfer, medical treatment or court appearance, within a twenty-mile radius from the transporting sheriff's office, shall be reimbursed in accordance with the provisions of the State Travel Reimbursement Act. Any transportation provided outside a twenty-mile radius from the transporting sheriff's office shall be reimbursed at a rate negotiated with the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services prior to transporting to or from any facility.
- F. Nothing in this section shall prohibit a law enforcement agency from entering into a lawful agreement with any other law enforcement agency to fulfill the requirements established by this
