AS INTRODUCED

A Concurrent Resolution congratulating the Tuttle Tigers, the 2017 Class 4A State Wrestling Champions; commending Head Coach Matt Surber for his leadership and dedication; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, the Tuttle Tigers wrestling team won their eighth consecutive Class 4A Dual State Championship and the school's 14th overall on February 20, 2017, at Oklahoma State Fair Arena; and

WHEREAS, the Tuttle Tigers also won the 2017 Class 4A State Championship, the school's ninth overall, with 197.5 points; and

WHEREAS, the Tuttle Tigers are ranked 11th in the country; and

WHEREAS, the Tuttle wrestling team was also named the 2017 Academic State Champions with an overall G.P.A. of 3.70; and

1 WHEREAS, the team had seven Individual State Champions including
2 Cale Johnson, Carson Berryhill, Luke Surber, Brik Filippo, Tanner
3 Johnson, Rhett Golowenski and Tanner Litterell; and

4 WHEREAS, the team had two State Runner-ups, Brady DeArmond and
5 Dustin Plott as well as Ryder Ramsey who placed third and Gunner
6 Meyer who got fourth place; and

7 WHEREAS, the victory was senior Tanner Litterell's fourth state
8 championship making him the second Tuttle Tiger since 2013 graduate,
9 Zachary Beard, to win four individual state titles; and

10 WHEREAS, seniors Tanner Litterell and Brik Filippo finished
11 their season undefeated, making them the first two Tuttle wrestlers
12 in Coach Matt Surber's tenure to finish the same season undefeated;
13 and

14 WHEREAS, during his eleven years as head coach, Matt Surber has
15 created a legacy of excellence and champions at Tuttle High School.

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 1ST SESSION
17 OF THE 56TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
18 CONCURRING THEREIN:

19 THAT the Legislature congratulates the Tuttle Tigers on winning
20 the 2017 Class 4A State Wrestling Championship, the Dual State
21 Championship and the Academic State Championship.

22 THAT the Legislature commends Head Coach Matt Surber for his
23 eleven years of leadership and dedication to the Tuttle wrestling
24 program.
