- 6. Rape by instrumentation resulting in bodily harm is rape by instrumentation in the first degree regardless of the age of the victim or the age of the person committing the crime; or
- 7. rape by instrumentation committed upon a person under fourteen (14) years of age.
- B. In all other cases, rape or rape by instrumentation is rape in the second degree.
- SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
