HOUSE BILL 1007

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to student transfers; allowing transfer students in certain grades to participate in certain activities; allowing certain exception; repealing 70 O.S. 2011, Section 8-103.2, which relates to eligibility of student transfers in extramural competitions; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 8-103.3 of Title 70, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Students in grades nine through twelve who transfer from a public school district or a private school into a public school district or private school, pursuant to the Education Open Transfer Act, before the fifth day of the receiving school's academic year shall be eligible to participate in school-related extramural competitions governed by the Oklahoma Secondary School Activities Association. Such participation shall be allowed for one transfer

1 per academic year, unless an emergency transfer is granted pursuant
2 to Section 8-104 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

3 SECTION 2. REPEALER 70 O.S. 2011, Section 8-103.2, is
4 hereby repealed.

5 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2017.

6 SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
7 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
8 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
9 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
