Funds budgeted for FY-19 may be encumbered only through June 30, 2019. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2019, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year. These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-18, and not required to pay obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-19, after
