AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the Board of Medicolegal
Investigations; making an appropriation; stating
purpose; requiring budgeting in certain categories
and amounts; providing for the duties and
compensation of employees; providing budgetary
limitations; making certain full-time-equivalent
employees contingent upon certain funding; providing
lapse dates; requiring and prohibiting certain budget
practices; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Board of
Medicolegal Investigations from any monies not otherwise
appropriated from the General Revenue of the State Treasury for the
fiscal year ending June 30, 2018, the sum of _____ Dollars
(\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties
imposed upon the Board of Medicolegal Investigations by law.

SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2018, the Board of Medicolegal Investigations shall budget all funds in the following categories and amounts:

SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Board of Medicolegal Investigations by law shall be set by the Chief Medical Examiner of the Board of Medicolegal Investigations. The Board of Medicolegal Investigations for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2018, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

1 SECTION 4. Appropriations made by this act, not including
2 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for
3 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2018 (hereafter FY-18) or may be
4 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2019 (hereafter FY-19).
5 Funds budgeted for FY-18 may be encumbered only through June 30,
6 2018, and must be expended by November 15, 2018. Any funds
7 remaining after November 15, 2018, and not budgeted for FY-19, shall
8 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal
9 year. Funds budgeted for FY-19 may be encumbered only through June
10 30, 2019. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2019, shall lapse
11 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.
12 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years
13 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-18, and not required to pay
14 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-19, after
15 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared
16 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds
17 from the FY-18 budget work program and after such revision has been
18 approved by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services.

19 SECTION 5. This act shall become effective July 1, 2017.
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
