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9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the Oklahoma State Bureau of
11 Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control; making an
12 appropriation; stating purpose; requiring budgeting
13 in certain categories and amounts; providing for the
14 duties and compensation of employees; providing
15 budgetary limitations; limiting amount of
16 appropriation which may be used for certain purpose;
17 authorizing transfer of funds to an agency special
18 account for certain purposes; limiting amount
19 authorized to be transferred; requiring promulgation
20 of certain rules; providing lapse dates; requiring
21 and prohibiting certain budget practices; and
22 providing an effective date.

23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

24 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma State
Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control from any monies not
otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State
Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2018, the sum of
_____ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to

1 perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma State Bureau of
2 Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control by law.

3 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2018, the
4 Oklahoma State Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control shall
5 budget all funds in the following categories and amounts:

15 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
16 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
17 upon the Oklahoma State Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs
18 Control by law shall be set by the Director of the Oklahoma State
19 Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control. The Oklahoma State
20 Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control for the fiscal year
21 ending June 30, 2018, shall be subject to the following budgetary
22 limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures
23 excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as
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1 may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of
2 Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

6 SECTION 4. Of the amount appropriated to the Oklahoma State
7 Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control by Section 1 of this
8 act, an amount not to exceed _____ (\$0.00) may be
9 transferred to an agency special account established pursuant to the
10 provisions of Section 34.56 of Title 62 of the Oklahoma Statutes.
11 Funds in this account are to purchase controlled dangerous
12 substances to be used as evidence in narcotic cases, for fees for
13 informers, or employees, and for other expenses necessary to
14 apprehend and convict violators of state laws regulating controlled
15 dangerous substances. The Director of the Oklahoma State Bureau of
16 Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control and the Director of the Office
17 of Management and Enterprise Services shall promulgate rules for the
18 expenditure of the funds transferred by this section.

19 SECTION 5. Appropriations made by this act, not including
20 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for
21 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2018 (hereafter FY-18) or may be
22 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2019 (hereafter FY-19).
23 Funds budgeted for FY-18 may be encumbered only through June 30,
24 2018, and must be expended by November 15, 2018. Any funds

1 remaining after November 15, 2018, and not budgeted for FY-19, shall
2 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal
3 year. Funds budgeted for FY-19 may be encumbered only through June
4 30, 2019. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2019, shall lapse
5 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.
6 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years
7 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-18, and not required to pay
8 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-19, after
9 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared
10 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds
11 from the FY-18 budget work program and after such revision has been
12 approved by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services.

13 SECTION 6. This act shall become effective July 1, 2017.

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
