SECTION 5. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Office of the Attorney General by law shall be set by the Office of the Attorney General. The Office of the Attorney General for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2018, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

SECTION 6. Appropriations made by this act, not including appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2018 (hereafter FY-18) or may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2019 (hereafter FY-19). Funds budgeted for FY-18 may be encumbered only through June 30, 2018, and must be expended by November 15, 2018. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2018, and not budgeted for FY-19, shall
