HOUSE BILL 1105

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to public health; amending 63 O.S. 2010, Section 96, which relates to the authority to dissect, operate or experiment on dead bodies; authorizing the retaining of tissue for certain purpose; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 63 O.S. 2011, Section 96, is amended to read as follows:

Any and all schools, colleges and persons who may be designated by the Anatomical Board shall be, and are, authorized to dissect, operate upon, examine and experiment upon bodies distributed to them by the Board's agent and no others. These schools, colleges and persons are also authorized to retain tissue from bodies distributed to them and to donate the tissue to a person or entity for the purpose of training a dog to search for human remains. Such dissections, operations, examinations and experiments shall not be considered as amenable under any already existing laws for the prevention of mutilation of dead human bodies. Such persons,

1 schools or colleges shall keep a record, sufficient for
2 identification, of each body received from the Anatomical Board or
3 agent. The record shall be subject to inspection by the Board or
4 its authorized officer or agent.

5 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
