6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to cities and towns; creating the
8 Oklahoma Municipal Safe Lighting Matching Grant
9 Revolving Fund; providing for sources of revenue;
10 authorizing expenditures; prescribing method for
11 expenditures; providing for codification; providing
12 an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 40-125 of Title 11, unless there
16 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund
18 for the Oklahoma Department of Commerce to be designated the
19 "Oklahoma Municipal Safe Lighting Matching Grant Revolving Fund".
20 The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year
21 limitations, and shall consist of all monies received by the
22 Oklahoma Department of Commerce from such sources as may be provided
23 by law. All monies accruing to the credit of said fund are hereby
24 appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the Oklahoma

1 Department of Commerce for the purpose of providing matching grants
2 to eligible municipalities in order to provide safe lighting in
3 designated high-risk areas. Expenditures from said fund shall be
4 made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims
5 filed as prescribed by law with the Director of the Office of
6 Management and Enterprise Services for approval and payment.

7 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2017.

8 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
9 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
10 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
11 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
