HOUSE BILL 1306

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to crimes and punishments; amending 21 O.S. 2011, Section 701.9, which relates to penalties for first and second degree murder; modifying penalty for certain first degree murder convictions; updating language; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2011, Section 701.9, is amended to read as follows:

Section 701.9 A. A person who is convicted of or pleads guilty or nolo contendere to murder in the first degree shall be punished by death, by imprisonment for life without parole or by imprisonment for life. A person who is convicted of or pleads guilty or nolo contendere to murder in the first degree, as described in subsection E of Section 701.7 of this title, shall be punished by death and shall not be entitled to or afforded the benefit of receiving a punishment of imprisonment for life without parole, imprisonment for life or deferment of the sentence.

1       B. A person who is convicted of or pleads guilty or nolo  
2       contendere to murder in the second degree shall be guilty of a  
3       felony punishable by imprisonment in ~~a state penal institution~~ the  
4       custody of the Department of Corrections for not less than ten (10)  
5       years nor more than life.

6       SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
