Beginning May 1, 1990, no

person shall be eligible to be a candidate for or elected to be a member of the board of education of a school district or technology center school district unless the person has been awarded a high school diploma or certificate of high school equivalency. In school districts that are divided into election districts, a candidate must have resided in the district for at least six (6) months preceding the first day of the filing period and have been a registered voter registered with the county election board at an address located within the geographical boundaries of the election district for six (6) months preceding the first day of the filing period. Beginning May 1, 1990, no person shall be eligible to be a candidate for or elected to be a member of the board of education unless the person has been awarded a high school diploma or certificate of high school equivalency.

- B. The requirement that a candidate for member of a board of education of a school district or technology center school district resides and has been a registered voter in the district for at least (6) months preceding the first day of the filing period as set forth in subsection A of this section shall not apply in the event the district has been annexed or consolidated, provided that the candidate resides and is a registered voter in the district on the first day of the filing period.
- $\underline{\text{C.}}$ To be eligible to vote in a school district election or a technology center school district election, a person must be
