- 2. Ensure that such geographic locations include low-, mid- and high-economic-income areas in order to provide greater accessibility to caregivers; and
- 3. Provide that the locations to be selected shall include schools, city and county facilities in which no usage fee shall be charged.
- SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
  in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3002.4 of Title 56, unless there
  is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
  - The Department of Human Services shall be required to promulgate rules to:
- 12 1. Publicize information to caregivers regarding available 13 services;
  - 2. Provide assistance to caregivers in gaining access to available services;
    - 3. Provide individual counseling, organize support groups and provide caregiver training; and
    - 4. Provide respite care to enable caregivers to be temporarily relieved from their caregiving responsibilities.
- SECTION 4. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
