15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
16	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 43 O.S. 2011, Section 114, as last
17	amended by Section 1, Chapter 289, O.S.L. 2016 (43 O.S. Supp. 2016,
18	Section 114), is amended to read as follows:
19	Section 114. Court-ordered A. Except as provided in subsection
20	C of this section, court-ordered past-due child support payments,
21	court-ordered payments of suit monies and judgments for support
22	pursuant to Section 83 of Title 10 of the Oklahoma Statutes and
23	Sections 238.1 and 238.6B of Title 56 of the Oklahoma Statutes shall
24	draw interest at the rate of two percent (2%) per year.

B. Past-due child support payments accruing after the establishment of the current support order shall draw interest from the date they become delinquent. Lump-sum judgments pursuant to Titles 10 and 56 of the Oklahoma Statutes for support owed prior to the establishment of current support shall draw interest from the first day of the month after the lump-sum judgment is entered. The interest shall be collected in the same manner as the payments upon which the interest accrues. Amounts collected shall be applied to the past-due child support first and the accruing interest second.

C. Court-ordered past-due child support payments, court-ordered payments of suit monies and judgments for support pursuant to

Section 83 of Title 10 of the Oklahoma Statutes and Sections 238.1

and 238.6B of Title 56 of the Oklahoma Statutes entered beginning

November 1, 2017, shall draw interest at the rate in effect for judgments rendered during that calendar year as certified by the Administrative Director of the Courts pursuant to subsection I of Section 727.1 of Title 12 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 43 O.S. 2011, Section 118.4, is amended to read as follows:

Section 118.4 A. Child support or any claim thereto shall not be directly or indirectly assigned, except as provided in subsection B of this section and in subsection C of Section 237 of Title 56 of the Oklahoma Statutes. Any assignment of child support to the
