6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to agriculture; requiring certain
8 seed dealer to provide the producer with certain
9 receipts; requiring storage containers to be
10 identified; requiring records be maintained;
11 authorizing the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture,
12 Food, and Forestry to inspect certain facilities for
13 compliance; providing for codification; and providing
14 an effective date.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 8-40 of Title 2, unless there is
18 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 A. Any seed dealer or processor purchasing mung beans (*Vigna*
20 *radiata*) from a producer shall provide the following to the
21 producer:

22 1. A valid weight receipt identifying the entry and exit weight
23 of the transporting vehicle; and

24 2. A weight receipt identifying the weight of the mung beans
after cleaning.

1 B. The seed dealer or processor purchasing the mung beans shall
2 individually identify the storage containers to allow traceability
3 to the particular producer.

4 C. The seed dealer or processor shall maintain records of the
5 above for all mung bean transactions for a period of three (3)
6 years.

7 D. The Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry
8 may inspect any seed dealer or processor facility to determine
9 compliance with this section. Any costs of inspection, including
10 mileage and inspector's hourly rate, shall be billed to the
11 facility.

12 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
