NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 14-135 of Title 70, unless there 17 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 18 On the effective date of this act, the Agricultural 19 Extension Division under the Board of Regents for Oklahoma 20 Agricultural and Mechanical Colleges shall be placed under the 21 authority of the Oklahoma Department of Career and Technology 22 Education. Except as otherwise provided for in this section, the 23 transfer shall include all real property, buildings, furniture,

equipment, supplies, records, personnel, assets, current and future

1 liabilities, fund balances, encumbrances, obligations and
2 indebtedness associated with the Oklahoma Agricultural Extension
3 Division.

- B. All employees of the Oklahoma Agricultural Extension
 Division on the effective date of this act, including related
 liabilities for sick leave, annual leave, holidays, unemployment
 benefits and workers' compensation benefits accruing prior to the
 effective date of this act, to such personnel shall be transferred
 to the Oklahoma Department of Career and Technology Education as of
 the effective date of this act. It is the intent of the Legislature
 that, to the extent possible, the Oklahoma Department of Career and
 Technology Education ensure that the employees retain pay and
 benefits, as much as possible, including longevity, dependent
 insurance benefits, seniority, rights and other privileges or
 benefits.
 - C. Appropriate conveyances and other documents shall be executed by January 1, 2018, to effectuate the transfer of property owned by the Oklahoma Agricultural Extension Division to the Oklahoma Department of Career and Technology Education.
 - D. Any monies donated or accruing to or in the name of the Oklahoma Agricultural Extension Division after the effective date of this act shall be transferred to the Oklahoma Department of Career and Technology Education. Any other monies from appropriations, fees, licenses, fines, penalties or other similar types of monies

that accrue in any funds or accounts after the effective date of
this act, in the name of the Oklahoma Agricultural Extension

Division or maintained for the benefit of the Oklahoma Agricultural
Extension, are transferred to the Oklahoma Department of Career and
Technology Education.

- E. The Oklahoma Department of Career and Technology Education shall succeed to any contractual rights and responsibilities incurred by the Oklahoma Agricultural Extension Division.
- F. The rules of the Oklahoma Agricultural Extension Division that are in effect on the effective date of this act shall be enforceable by the Oklahoma Department of Career and Technology Education until the Oklahoma Department of Career and Technology Education establishes rules.
- SECTION 2. REPEALER 70 O.S. 2011, Sections 3418 and 3419, are hereby repealed.
- SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
