passengers and potential passengers and notify all taxicab drivers in their employ of such policy;

- 2. Require taxicab drivers in their employ to comply with all applicable laws regarding nondiscrimination against passengers or potential passengers on the basis of destination, race, color, national origin, religious belief, religious affiliation, sex, disability, or age;
- 3. Require taxicab drivers in their employ to comply with all applicable laws relating to accommodation of service animals;
- 4. Not impose additional charges for providing services to persons with physical disabilities because of those disabilities; and
- 5. Provide passengers an opportunity to indicate whether they require a wheelchair-accessible vehicle. If the person, firm, or corporation cannot arrange a wheelchair-accessible prearranged ride in any instance, it shall direct the passenger to an alternate provider of wheelchair-accessible service, if available.
- B. The Oklahoma Corporation Commission shall promulgate rules as needed to implement the provisions of this act. The Commission may assess fines for noncompliance with this act or with promulgated rules.
- SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
