HOUSE BILL 1638

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to schools; requiring certain private schools to publish certain annual report regarding children with disabilities; setting forth information to be included in report; requiring report to be made available on school's website by certain date each year; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 13-101.3 of Title 70, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. Each private school that directly or indirectly receives revenue from the state in the form of a voucher, credit or scholarship shall be required to publish an annual report which contains the following information for the preceding school year:

1. Services provided to children with disabilities, including services available to children with mild, moderate or severely profound needs and a description of any related services available, including speech therapy, occupational therapy and physical therapy.

1 If the school does not offer any services to children with
2 disabilities, it shall be required to disclose such information;

3 2. If the school contracts with a public school district to
4 provide services to children with disabilities, it shall be required
5 to disclose such information;

6 3. The total number of certified special education teachers and
7 the total number of paraeducators employed at the school; and

8 4. The total number of children with disabilities enrolled at
9 the school.

10 B. The report shall be made available by June 30 each year on
11 the school's website.

12 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
