HOUSE BILL 1648

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to state government; creating the Administrative Salary and Compensation Act of 2017; limiting compensation for state administrators; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 840-2.17A of Title 74, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. This section shall be known and may be cited as the "Administrative Salary and Compensation Act of 2017".

B. Any state agency, department, commission, institution or school district receiving revenue from legislative appropriations or similar means of public funding shall not authorize salary, compensation or other fringe benefit increases for any director, chief executive officer, superintendent, president or other such administrative roles during or immediately succeeding any fiscal

1 year in which a revenue failure, as declared by the Secretary of
2 Finance, occurred.

3 C. Compensation for health insurance or travel expenses paid to
4 the individuals listed in subsection B of this section may increase
5 by a maximum of five (5) percent in a fiscal year during which
6 revenue failures were declared or in the year immediately following
7 such revenue failure.

8 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
