12	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified

14	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
15	A. It is the intent of the Legislature that the Oklahoma State
16	Regents for Higher Education adopt a policy for each institution
17	within the Oklahoma State System of Higher Education that requires
18	the acceptance of no fewer than forty (40) credit hours of college
19	courses approved by the American Council on Education toward the
20	award of a degree from such institution.
21	B. It is the further intent of the Legislature that the
22	Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education adopt a policy for each
23	institution within the Oklahoma State System of Higher Education
24	that permits a provider which offers college courses approved by the

    credit be articulated as equivalent to particular credits offered by

    the institution. If the institution declines to articulate the
 4
    provider's credits as equivalent to its own credit to the
 5

    institution's decision to the Oklahoma Secretary of Education.
 7
    Secretary's decision shall be final and binding upon both the
 8
    institution and the provider.
 9
        SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
