HOUSE BILL 1775

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to public health and safety;  
requiring the state to accept federal funding for  
health care coverage available under certain federal  
acts; providing for codification; and providing an  
effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-124 of Title 63, unless there  
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

In order to secure high-quality, affordable health care for all  
Oklahomans, the State of Oklahoma shall accept federal funding  
available under the "Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act"  
(Public Law 111-148, March 23, 2010) and "Health Care and Education  
Reconciliation Act of 2010" (Public Law 111-152, March 30, 2010).

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.

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
