12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
13	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 2, State Question No. 781,
14	Initiative Petition No. 405, is amended to read as follows:
15	Section 631. A. There is hereby created in the State Treasury
16	a revolving fund to be designated the "County Community Safety
17	Investment Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject
18	to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of all monies received
19	pursuant to Section 633 of Title 57 of the Oklahoma Statutes.
20	B. All monies appropriated and accruing to the credit of the
21	fund shall be budgeted and expended by the Office of Management and
22	Enterprise Services Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse
23	Services for the sole purpose of providing funds to counties to
24	provide community rehabilitative programming, including but not

- limited to mental health and substance abuse services within the counties. Funds shall be disbursed in proportion to county population, as reported in the most recent census.
 - C. Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Commissioner of the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services for approval and payment.
 - D. The Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise

 Commissioner of the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse

 Services shall promulgate rules necessary to implement the provisions of this act.
- SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2017.
 - SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
