15	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 63 O.S. 2011, Section 1-319, as						
16	amended by Section 1, Chapter 63, O.S.L. 2013 (63 O.S. Supp. 2016,						
17	Section 1-319), is amended to read as follows:						
18	Section 1-319. A. A burial transit permit issued under the						
19	laws of another state which accompanies a dead body or fetus brought						
20	into this state shall be authority for final disposition of the body						
21	or fetus in this state.						
22	B. A <u>disinterment</u> permit for disinterment and reinterment shall						
23	be required prior to disinterment <u>and reinterment</u> of a dead body or						
24	fetus except as authorized by regulation or otherwise provided by						

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1 | law. Such permit shall be issued by the State Registrar of Vital
2 | Records to a licensed funeral director, embalmer, or other person
3 | acting as such, upon proper application.

- c. Application for <u>a</u> disinterment shall include proof of notice to the owner(s) of the interment lot or burial space, if other than the applicant all of the following: the consent of the cemetery, the consent of the interment right owner, and the consent of the next of kin. The consent of the next of kin shall be completed by the next of kin in order of priority as established in Section 1158 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes.
- D. Application for disinterment shall include proof of notice to all surviving adult children of the decedent, if other than the applicant If the dead body or fetus is to be disinterred and reinterred in the same cemetery, a disinterment permit is not required.
- E. If the dead body or fetus is to be disinterred and reinterred in the same cemetery, a notice of disinterment and reinterment shall be completed, signed by the funeral director and the next of kin, and then submitted to the State Registrar of Vital Records at the State Department of Health within five (5) days of such action.
- F. The forms for the Disinterment Permit and Notice of

 Disinterment and Reinterment shall be obtained from the State

 Registrar of Vital Records.
