6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to public health and safety;
8 directing the Oklahoma Health Care Authority to
9 require parenting-education classes for benefit
10 recipients; directing the promulgation of rules;
11 providing for codification; and providing an
12 effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5009.6 of Title 63, unless there
16 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 The Oklahoma Health Care Authority shall require any pregnant
18 person or person with children under the age of nineteen (19) years
19 of age who makes an application to the Oklahoma Health Care
20 Authority to receive any type of benefits, either for himself or
21 herself or for an immediate family member, to take parenting-
22 education classes as approved by the Oklahoma Health Care Authority
23 before receiving any benefits. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority

1 shall promulgate rules necessary to implement the provisions of this
2 section.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
