7 An Act relating to oil and gas; requiring certain
8 elimination of noise and vibration; vesting authority
9 to enforce requirement; providing for codification;
10 and providing an effective date.

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12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 317.2 of Title 52, unless there
15 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 A. All oil and gas operations, including but not limited to
17 drilling, exploration, fracture stimulation and production, shall be
18 conducted in such a manner as to eliminate as far as possible noise
19 and vibration and shall be in accordance with the best available
20 technology for such oil and gas operations available at the time.

21 B. The Corporation Commission is vested with jurisdiction,
22 power and authority, and it shall be its duty to promulgate and
23 enforce rules and issue and enforce orders relating to the
24 provisions of this section.

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SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
