This section shall be known and may be cited 18 as the "Bill of Rights and Other Important Amendments Monument 19 Display Act". 20 The State Capitol Preservation Commission or designee is 21 hereby authorized to permit and arrange for the placement on the 22 State Capitol grounds of a suitable monument displaying the first 23 ten amendments to the Constitution of the United States, commonly
