6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to public finance; establishing the
8 Oklahoma State Government Open Records One-Stop
9 Initiative; imposing duties on the Chief Information
10 Officer; providing for delivery of certain documents;
11 requiring electronic delivery; requiring certain
12 documents be made available to the public; providing
13 for statutory construction; providing for
14 codification; and providing an effective date.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 34.11.11 of Title 62, unless
18 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 A. There is hereby established the "Oklahoma State Government
20 Open Records One-Stop Initiative".

21 B. The Chief Information Officer shall develop and maintain an
22 online web presence at the web address *OpenRecords.ok.gov*. The site
23 shall allow the public to file a request for documents pursuant to
24 the terms of the Oklahoma Open Records Act.

1 C. Upon finding that requested documents are open records under
2 the provisions of the Oklahoma Open Records Act, the Chief
3 Information Officer shall retrieve and deliver the documents to the
4 requester in accordance with the procedures of the Oklahoma Open
5 Records Act.

6 D. Documents requested through the open records web portal
7 shall be delivered to the requester in electronic format.

8 E. Immediately following delivery of the documents requested to
9 the requester, the electronic material shall be made available to
10 the public through the *data.ok.gov* web portal.

11 F. Nothing in this section shall be construed to change any
12 obligation of public officials to comply with already existing
13 provisions of the Oklahoma Open Records Act.

14 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
