L3	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 57 O.S. 2011, Section 503, is
L 4	amended to read as follows:
L5	Section 503. A. There is hereby created the State Board of
16	Corrections which shall be the governing board of the Department of
L7	Corrections herein created.
L8	$\underline{\text{B.}}$ The Board shall consist of seven (7) members who shall $\underline{\text{to}}$ be
L 9	appointed as follows:
20	1. Five members shall be appointed by the Governor with the
21	advice and consent of the Senate. One member shall be appointed
22	from each congressional district and any remaining members shall be
23	appointed from the state at large. However, when congressional
24	districts are redrawn, each member appointed prior to July 1 of the

year in which such modification becomes effective shall complete the current term of office and appointments made after July 1 of the year in which such modification becomes effective shall be based on the redrawn districts. Appointments made after July 1 of the year in which such modification becomes effective shall be from any redrawn districts which are not represented by a board member until such time as each of the modified congressional districts are represented by a board member. No appointments may be made after July 1 of the year in which such modification becomes effective if such appointment would result in more than two members serving from the same modified district;

- 2. One member shall be appointed by the Speaker of the Oklahoma

 House of Representatives and shall be a sheriff while serving in

 that capacity; and
- 3. One member shall be appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the Oklahoma State Senate and shall be a sheriff while serving in that capacity.
- C. The terms of office of two members shall expire on March 15, 1969, and each six (6) years thereafter; the terms of two members shall expire on March 15, 1971, and each six (6) years thereafter; and the terms of three members shall expire on March 15, 1973, and each six (6) years thereafter.
- $\underline{\text{D.}}$ Not more than four members of the Board shall be of the same political party.
