17	Section 13-116. A. School district personnel shall be
18	prohibited from using corporal punishment or seclusion on students
19	identified with the most significant cognitive disabilities

21	Education unless addressed in an annual individualized education
22	program (IEP) developed in accordance with the Individuals with
23	Disabilities Education Act (IDEA).

B. A waiver to the provisions of subsection A of this section shall be granted if the parent or legal guardian of a student provides written consent. C. As used in this section  $\tau$ : 1. "corporal Corporal punishment" means the deliberate infliction of physical pain by hitting, paddling, spanking, slapping or any other physical force used as a means of discipline; and 2. "Seclusion" means involuntary confinement alone in a room or area where the student is physically prevented from leaving, usually because the door or exit is locked or obstructed. SECTION 2.
